

Guidelines For CA / ICWA (CMA) / CS Scholarship (IWCS) 2025-26

Objective

To support the education of students belonging to notified minority communities (Muslims, Christians (all sects), Sikhs, Buddhists, Jains, and Parsis) who are preparing for intermediate or final examinations for CA/ICWA(CMA)/CS in Kerala.

Scholarship amount

The scholarship amount is **₹15,000 per student** for the academic year.

Eligibility criteria

- The scholarships will be given to students who are preparing for intermediate or final examinations in Kerala.
- Priority will be given to those belonging to the BPL category. In the absence of BPL applicants, APL category students with an annual income of up to ₹8,00,000 from minority religious groups will be considered.
- The applicant must be a permanent resident of Kerala.
- 50% of the scholarships are reserved for females. If there are insufficient female applicants, male students can be considered.
- The scholarship will be granted only once during the course period.
- Students studying for the Intermediate Examination should have completed their Foundation Course or possess a degree with at least 60% marks. Students preparing for the Final Examination should have passed the Intermediate Examination.

How to apply

2. Click on “**One-time registration.**”
3. Login using username & password
4. Complete profile
5. Add qualification details

6. Click on Apply for scholarship.
7. Click on Final submit & download print

Documents to be submitted

- Printout of the applicant's registration form.
- Copy of mark lists of SSLC, Plus Two, Degree, Foundation Pass Certificate, Intermediate Pass Certificate etc.
- Documents certifying that you are studying for the course (Admission card, receipt of payment of tuition fees, ID card, etc.).
- Copy of the first page of the bank passbook in the applicant's own name.
- All bank account-related details (Account Number, IFSC Code, Bank and Branch Name) should be checked and ensured to be correct. The department will not be responsible for rejection of the scholarship due to incorrect bank details.
- Copy of Aadhaar card
- Copy of Community Certificate / Minority Certificate.
- Income Certificate issued by the Village Officer
- Copy of Ration Card.
